Assembly programme including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Life at University</li> <li>- Apprenticeship opportunities</li> <li>- Careers in the local area</li> </ul>	Term 1/2	100% of Year Group	Students gain comprehensive understanding of a range of options available to them in their steps beyond KS5.
Full programme of advice and guidance in assembly and Social Wellbeing about University and the UCAS process.	Term 5 / 6	100% of Year Group	An assembly and Social Well Being programme is delivered using various speakers, guiding students through the UCAS process. Includes talks from University of Sussex and University of Southampton.
Higher Education Conference (London)	Varied	100% of Year Group	A visit to a major Higher Education conference, with access to universities, apprenticeship providers and employment information.
University Visits	Varied	50% of Year Group	Visits to various universities, including Bristol, Oxford and Cambridge (This would include Oxbridge talks)
Access to careers advisor in school	Terms 1 – 6	As required – by appointment. School will pro-actively promote appointments with students who need guidance.	Students have access to individualised advice and guidance whenever required. In Year 12, this service might be used if, for example, a student wants to investigate the possibility of moving into an apprenticeship, or wants help with university course choices.
Work Experience	Term 6	100% of Year Group.	All students spend time in a local, national or international place of work. They gain confidence, experience of working environment, and feedback from their employers.
Careers Convention	Term 3	Interested students attend.	Large scale careers event, with access to over 100 employers. Students pro-actively encouraged to attend.

Careers Convention	Term 3	Interested students attend.	Large scale careers event, with access to over 100 employers. Students pro-actively encouraged to attend.
